FIREARMS SAFETY RULES

1. Treat all weapons as if they are loaded.
2. Keep your finger off the trigger and outside the trigger guard until you have made the conscious decision to shoot.
3. Always point the muzzle in a safe direction.
4. Don't point your weapon at anything you aren't willing to destroy.
5. Be aware of your target, backstop and beyond.

SAFE UNLOADING PROCEDURES

1. Point the weapon in a safe direction, finger off the trigger, indexed high along the frame, receiver, or slide. Not along the trigger guard.
2. Place the selector or decocking lever in the safe mode.
3. Pull the magazine from the weapon and/or verify the magazine is removed from the weapon.
4. Pull the cocking lever, charging handle, or slide to the rear and lock the bolt or slide to the rear.
5. Visually and physically verify there are no live rounds in the weapon.

RANGE POLICY

1. Always obey firearm safety rules and unloading procedures as listed above.
2. Follow all commands from the instructor. Failure to do so can result in being removed from the range.
3. Instructors reserve the right to remove any student from the range, firing line, or classroom for any safety violation or failure to follow instructions.
4. Adhere to the course-of-fire as outlined by the instructor. If clarification is needed, ask the instructor before commencing the drill.
5. Always wear hearing and eye protection while in the active range.
6. No loaded weapons in the classroom. Handguns and rifles should be unloaded before entering the facility.
7. Any weapons handling in the classroom will be conducted at the direction of the instructor.
8. All shoulder fired weapons will remain in the case while in the classroom.
9. Students must sign and complete all Range Facility releases and waivers prior to the start of training.
10. Prior to leaving the range, all students will make their weapons safe and inspected by the instructor.
